Background

Mission Direct responds to Jesus' call to prayer for more people to be workers to help the harassed and helpless, found in Matthew 9:36-38. We find financially poor communities around the world as well as visionary Christian leaders within those leaders who are making a difference so that we can then call others to volunteer to help them. Our volunteers build schools and safe housing for rescued children in developing world countries. Through their love and compassion, they go so far beyond this and bring individual care to individual situations that they encounter while they are serving on our projects.

Volunteer Ambassadors fulfill answer Jesus' call for workers in a different way. They help to raise awareness of our work by attending events to talk about our it and to encourage others to get involved in prayer, fundraising activity or volunteering. This is a really important role as it helps us to reach new people, inspire new fundraising activity, and thank our supporters for the work they are doing.
